1. Our commitment

NC Safety Solutions wants as many people as possible to be able to use the website at www.ncsafety solutions.co.uk. We aim for the website to meet the Web Content Accessibility Guidelines (WCAG) 2.2 at level AA, and accessibility is considered whenever we add or change pages.

That means, for example, that you should be able to change colours, contrast levels and fonts using browser or device settings, zoom in up to 200% without text spilling off the screen, navigate the website using a keyboard alone, and use a screen reader to listen to most of the content.

2. What we have done

- Semantic HTML with a logical heading structure on every page.
- A "skip to content" link for keyboard users.
- Visible focus outlines on all interactive elements.
- Form fields with proper labels, and errors reported by the browser's native validation.
- Reduced-motion support: animations are disabled when your device asks for reduced motion.
- Text colours chosen for adequate contrast against their backgrounds.
- A responsive layout that works with zoom up to 200% and on small screens.
- Descriptive page titles and link text.

3. Known limitations

- Some decorative background effects (gradients and floating shapes) are purely visual. They carry no information and are hidden from screen readers.
- The enquiry form opens your email or WhatsApp app to send. If you cannot use either, email us directly and we will take your enquiry in whatever format works for you.
- Documents supplied to clients as PDF or Word files are produced to be readable with assistive technology, but older documents may not be fully tagged. We will provide an accessible version on request.



4. Tell us about a problem

If any part of the website is difficult to use with your device, browser or assistive technology, please email **nedim@ncsafety solutions.co.uk**. Tell us the page, what you were trying to do, and the technology you were using. We will do our best to fix the issue and, in the meantime, give you the information you needed in an accessible format.

We aim to acknowledge accessibility reports within 5 working days and to tell you what we plan to do within 20 working days.

5. Enforcement

The Equality and Human Rights Commission (EHRC) is responsible for enforcing the accessibility requirements that apply to UK websites under the Equality Act 2010. If you are not happy with how we respond to your report, you can contact the Equality Advisory and Support Service (EASS).

6. Technical information

This website is built as a modern, statically rendered site. Its accessibility is checked with automated tools and manual keyboard and screen-reader testing when significant changes are made.
