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1. Purpose

This policy explains the cookies and similar technologies used on the NC Safety Solutions website at www.ncsafetyolutions.co.uk, what each category does, and how you can control them. It should be read with our Privacy Notice.

2. What cookies are

Cookies are small text files placed on your device when you visit a website. Similar technologies include local storage and pixels. They allow a site to remember your preferences, keep you secure and, with your consent, measure how the site is used.

3. The law that applies

In the United Kingdom, cookies are governed by the Privacy and Electronic Communications Regulations 2003 (PECR) alongside the UK GDPR. PECR requires us to obtain your consent before placing any cookie that is not strictly necessary for the service you have requested, and to give you clear information about what each cookie does.

4. Cookies we use

Category	Purpose	Consent
Strictly necessary	Security, protection against cross-site request forgery, and remembering the cookie preferences you have chosen. Without these the site cannot work properly.	Always on. Consent not required by law.
Analytics	Anonymised insight into pages viewed, time on page and user journeys so we can improve the content and structure of the site. No personal profiles are built.	Opt-in through the cookie banner.
Marketing	Measuring whether our campaigns bring visitors to the site and, optionally, showing relevant information to people who have visited before.	Opt-in through the cookie banner.



Your preference is stored in your browser so we do not ask on every visit. If we add a new category of cookie in future, we will ask for your consent again before it is used.

5. How to change or withdraw your preferences

1. Use the cookie banner when it appears to accept all, reject all or choose categories.
2. To change a choice you have already made, clear the cookies and site data for this website in your browser settings and reload the page. The banner will appear again and you can choose new preferences.
3. You can also block or delete cookies for any website through your browser settings. Guidance is available from your browser's help pages. Blocking strictly necessary cookies may stop parts of the site working.

6. Third-party cookies

Where a third party sets a cookie through our site, for example an analytics provider, that provider is bound by a written contract with us and by their own privacy notice. We only enable such cookies after you have opted in.
